





## Pricing:

**The total cost of this ten-day tour of Greece is \$6,850.00 per person** (This price is based on a double occupancy. Single occupancy will cost an additional \$850.00.). This price includes the following:

- Round-trip air transportation from Dallas, Texas to Athens, Greece.
- All meals except one lunch. A special Farewell Dinner is also included.
- Excellent four/five-star accommodations. You will be staying at strategic locations so you can make the most of your time in Greece.
- One-day cruise of three Saronic Gulf islands.
- All ground transportation, transfers, and luggage handling.
- All entrance fees.

- Taxes and fees.

## Payment Options:

**Option A: Full Payment of \$6,850.00 per person with a completed registration form until November 1, 2019.**

**Option B:** Full payment of \$6,999.00 per person with a completed registration form by December 1, 2019.

**Option C:** Installment Payment Plan of \$6,999.00 per person. Three payments: a deposit of \$2,333.00 per person with a completed registration form, a second payment of \$2,333.00 per person by December 1, 2019, and a third payment of \$2,333.00 per person by January 1, 2020. *A late fee of \$50 will be added per person for each payment made after the deadline.*

\*A minimum deposit of \$2,333.00 per person and a completed registration form is necessary to secure a place on this tour. *There are only a limited number of seats available for this tour.*

\*\**Before November 1, 2019, all monies are refundable (minus \$500 service charge for having used a credit card if you should cancel). After November 1, 2019 and prior to December 1, 2019, all but \$2,333.00 per person is refundable. After December 1, 2019, no refund will be given. All cancellations must be received in writing. No monies are transferable. Cancellation fees apply regardless of the reason, including medical and family emergencies. All monies are refunded by check only.*
